

# 2015 Impact of Services



Helping people meet their basic needs and providing a safety-net of essential services.

## Hunger Relief

### (Food Shelves)



- Distributed 2.87 million pounds of food
- Served 18,922 people—easing the risk of hunger for 1 in 5 children

## Youth Services



- 1,031 youth participated
- 22,380 Teen Center visits

## Thrift Stores



- Generated \$1.55 million in revenue for program support
- Saved over 2 million pounds of items from landfills

## Refuge Network

### (Domestic Violence Services)



- Helped 2,366 victims of family violence
- Provided emergency shelter to 167 women and children
- Facilitated 22,264 advocacy contacts

## Aging Services



- Supported 521 older adults and caregivers
- Provided 7,498 hours of assistance to maintain independent living
